

Literacy

We listened to the story Emma Jane's Aeroplane about a little pilot who picked up friends on her travels around the world. Children learnt the repeated refrains from the story. Reception wrote a list of what they would take in their suitcase on a trip and KS1 change the tense of the words in the story from present tense to past tense.

Phonics

Reception 1: We have continued to practise blending and segmenting words using Phase 2 sounds and have started to try and sound out and say words in short phrases.

Reception 2: We are revising the Phase 3 sounds and read and write words using the new digraphs and trigraphs (/ow/ /or/ and /ur/this week!)

Reception 3: We have continued to practise reading words with consonant blends and have carried on trying to blend in our head! We have been writing short sentences using tricky words and phase 3 digraphs and trigraphs.

KS1: We have learnt the alternative spellings for the /ur/ and /e/ sounds.

Maths

Reception: Children have been making 10 in different ways and found matching amounts that go together to make 10 (number bonds). Children have used numicon and counters to find different ways to make 10.

KS1: We have revised number bonds to 10 and 20 and have used 100 squares to find number bonds to 100.

Topic

In Geography we revised the world's continents and oceans and found these on a map in an atlas.
